My sister sent me this email and I wanted to share it with you.

When meditating on the word Guidance, you keep seeing "dance" at the end of the word, and in some readings God's will is a lot like dancing. When two people try to lead, nothing feels right. The movement doesn't flow with the music, and everything is quite uncomfortable and jerky. When one person realizes that, and lets the other lead, both bodies begin to flow with the music. One gives gentle cues, perhaps with a nudge to the back or by pressing lightly in one direction or another. It's as if two become one body, moving beautifully. The dance takes surrender, willingness, and attentiveness from one person and gentle guidance and skill from the other. The word guidance starts with a "G" for God followed by "u" and "i."
