

Residence Hall Information

Glide-Crawford Residence Hall

was renovated in 2008 and accommodates 300 women on nine interconnecting floors. Each traditional-style floor houses approximately 34 women, all of whom share a community bathroom. The rooms include air conditioning, internet, cable TV, wood furniture and carpeting. There is a shared lobby and kitchenette located in the Commons area. Glide-Crawford is located on the semi-circle drive, making it close in proximity to most of the major facilities on campus.

Dorothy Kresge Residence Hall

was renovated in 2005 and accommodates nearly 250 women, in suite-style living. Each four- to five-person suites shares a bathroom, and a group of suites makes up a unit with a shared living space and kitchenette. The lower level of the hall is a traditional-style floor with a shared bathroom. Rooms include air conditioning, internet, cable TV, carpeting and wood furniture.

Johnson Residence Hall and Trustees

Residence Hall are the men's housing on campus. The Johnson Complex houses approximately 250 men and Trustees houses about 175. The halls are designed in a traditional style, sharing community bathrooms. Most rooms are designed to accommodate two residents. There are a few single rooms, usually reserved for seniors, and some three-man rooms. Each room includes air conditioning, internet, cable TV, carpet and wood furniture.

You should plan to bring...

Linens (bedding and towels), alarm clock, wastebaskets, bookshelves, iron, outlet strip, laundry basket or sack, lots of quarters, toiletries, telephone*, and clothing for various weather conditions. *One per room. See telephone system section.

You might want to bring...

Drying rack, small tools (hammer, crescent wrench, etc.), plastic dishes, silverware, television/DVD (one per room), "egg carton" foam pad for bed, storage crates, window coverings, radio/stereo (one per room), lamp (halogen lamps not allowed), desk lamp (needed for men's rooms), mini refrigerator*, a computer and printer (there are two internet connections in each double room and there is a computer lab in Kinlaw Library). *One small refrigerator (2.0 cubic feet, 2.0 amps) per room is allowed.

Electrical Appliances: State health and fire regulations prohibit cooking in individual rooms. Irons, popcorn poppers, coffee makers, microwave ovens, and other small appliances are permitted only in designated areas. There are kitchens in Johnson, Kresge, and Glide-Crawford. Coin-operated washers and dryers and ironing boards are provided in each residence hall.

Telephone System: Each room is assigned a telephone extension. Students must provide their own telephone. No answering machines are needed as each student has a private voice mail box as part of the campus telephone system. For questions regarding the telephone system, call 859.858.3511, ext. 2177.

Glide-Crawford (Women)

ROOMS: (excluding closets)

Double: 11' x 14' Suite: 11' x 11'6"

CLOSETS: (2 per room)

(Due to the age of the building, no extension cords are allowed in Glide-Crawford. ONLY power strips are to be used. Also, ONLY sticky tack can be used to hang posters on the walls. The school will issue 2 VERY SMALL nails per student for pictures.)

Johnson West (Men)

ROOMS: (excluding closets) 14'4" x 13'7"

CLOSETS: (2 per room) 5' deep x 3' wide

WINDOWS: (2 per room) 4'8" x 2'6" (Shades at all windows)

CARPETING COLOR: burgundy, teal, tan, gray tweed

STANDARD FURNITURE:

BEDS—2; loftable; 80" mattresses

DESKS—2 in double room, 34.5" deep with extension, 22.5" deep without, 42.5" wide x 20" high

HUTCH—12.5" deep x 40" wide x 20" high

DRESSERS—2 in each room, 3 drawers each; 30" x 24" x 30"

**Personal lofts are not allowed in the residence halls, due to safety and liability concerns. Most beds have the option of being lofted. A limited number of 84" mattresses are available on request. Note: 80" mattresses require extra-long sheets.*

Johnson East (Men)

ROOMS: (excluding closets) 13' x 14'

CLOSETS: (2 per room) 4' deep x 2'8" wide

WINDOWS: (2 per room) 4'6" x 2'6" (Shades at all windows)

CARPETING COLOR: burgundy, teal, tan, gray tweed

BEDS—2; loftable; 80" mattresses

DESKS—2 in double room, 34.5" deep with extension, 22.5" deep without, 42.5" wide x 30" high

(Johnson East 2nd floor and Sarah Johnson House (women) have the same dimensions as Johnson East, with a bath in each room, one closet and one wardrobe.)

CLOSETS: (2 in double room) 3'9" x 20" with 2 shelves

WINDOWS: 5' x 3' (mini-blinds)

CARPETING COLOR: blue tweed

DESKS—2 in double room, 42" x 34" desk extender attached, 3 drawers with a keyboard stowaway drawer and a desk chair
