Computer Lab Proposal: Propose a computer lab in the stuce. Passed and in effect.

Networking proposal: The proposal was asking for the network team to open ports for gaming on campus. As it stood the only way to play online gaming (even clash of clans) you had to go to the Sally center because they had the fastest internet and all the ports were open that were needed. The proposal passed and Network opened the ports and allows online gaming. Right now the only issue is Xbox because you can't sign into an internet browser to login into the network. Library Comment: "For this specific proposal, as it impacts the library, I can offer the following two observations as to why it has not been implemented fully. (Of course, as you are probably aware, we do currently offer late night study in Farm Boys every semester during the week of Final Exams and the week before Finals).

The two observations:

1. If I recall correctly, at the time this proposal was discussed, some SGA members weren't sure there would be enough use of the area to warrant late night study throughout the semester. From my own observation (and we do have data if you want it), late night study is fairly well used during Finals time, but I myself haven't heard of a lot of demand for it at other times of the semester.
2. The second, connected observation is that late night study needs to be monitored by at least one paid student worker. Typically, though, during late night study now there are two student workers from the Center for Academic Excellence who monitor the space. So, there would have to be enough budgetary funds available to cover the hourly wages of student monitors, and enough students willing to work that late night study time frame throughout the semester.

Hope that helps give you some context! There's really no reason in my mind that it couldn't be done, if there was enough interest and money to support it. The procedures for securing the area and disarming the doors are fairly straightforward from a logistical end."

Open Dorm Proposal

This proposal had the purpose of having a schedule for open dorm that rotated between each dorm. The proposal passed and there is now actually open dorm every Friday at every dorm.

Compost Proposal*

This proposal suggested that composting be used for leftover food in the cafeteria and be given to mission farm. Currently no composting takes place in the cafeteria. Will look into at next Food Service meeting.

Eagle ID Proposal*

This is a proposal to create a second account on the Eagle ID that could be used at certain pre-approved locations off campus. It is a separate fund that parents could directly deposit into. The proposal passed, but it did not happen. Will look into this issue further.

Recycling for the Cafeteria*

This proposal suggested that recycling bins be utilized in the cafeteria. Currently no recycling program takes place in the cafeteria, but most items from the Bistro are disposable anyway. Will discuss at next Food Service meeting.

Recycling Bin Proposal*

This proposal suggested that recycling bins be placed into the mens and women's dorms. Using ASC money, recycling bins were purchased for Glide Crawford and Kresge dorms. There are currently recycling bins in every dorm on campus.
