

Required Film Specifications and File Upload Instructions

- ✓ MPEG-4 file (.mp4) with H.264 Codec
- √ Video Resolution: 1920 X 1080p 24 fps (23.976)
- ✓ Data rate: Target bitrate 20 Mbps, Max bitrate 24 Mbps (Using High encoding profile)
- ✓ Audio: AAC codec, 320 kbps, 48kHz, Stereo

Steps to export H.264 .mp4 file from Adobe Premiere Pro CC:

- 1. From the Menu, choose "Export", "Media..."
- 2. In the "Format" dropdown menu choose "H.264"
- 3. In the "Preset" dropdown menu choose "High Quality 1080p HD"
- 4. Scroll down to confirm the following settings:

In the Video Tab

Basic Video Settings:

Width: 1920 Height: 1080

Frame Rate: 23.976 Field Order: Progressive Aspect: Square Pixels (1.0)

TV Standard: NTSC

Render at Maximum Depth: This may be checked to render color at 32 bit for better compositing and visual effects. (Additional render time will be required. Use only as necessary.)

Encoding Settings, Performance: Software Encoding (Computers with more robust graphics processing may give you the option for hardware encoding. It is recommended to use Software Encoding.) Encoding Settings, Profile: High Encoding Settings, Level: 4.2 Bitrate Encoding: VBR, 1 pass Target Bitrate [Mbps]: 20 Maximum Bitrate [Mbps]: 24

In the Audio Tab

Audio Format Settings, Audio Format: AAC
Basic Audio Settings, Audio Codec: AAC
Basic Audio Settings, Sample Rate: 48000 Hz
Basic Audio Settings, Channels: Stereo
Basic Audio Settings, Audio Quality: High
Bitrate Settings, Bitrate [kbps]: 320
Advanced Settings, Precedence: Bitrate

Steps to upload your film to Google Drive and share a link on the online submission form:

- 1. Export your film via the specification given above.
- 2. Login to your Google account or create a free Google account and access Google Drive: https://www.google.com/drive/
- 3. In the Personal box, click "Go To Google Drive." Be sure to have at least 2 GB of free space.
- 4. Locate the exported file that you made of your film. Be sure your film is named with your first and last name followed by the title as shown in this example "FirstLastTitle.mp4".
- 5. Drag the file onto the Google Drive page and it will begin uploading.
- 6. When the file has uploaded, do these two very important steps:
 - Right click on your file, click **Share.** In the box below Share with people and groups, type highbridgesubmissions@gmail.com. Press Enter. Be sure "Editor" is visible at the right. Click **Send.**
 - Right click on your file, click Get link. Verify that Anyone with the link and Editor are selected below.
 Then click Copy link in the lower left. Paste this link on your submission form where requested.

Note: **Do not delete** your film from your Google Drive account until after the festival. The shared file will be processed by the Highbridge Team and must remain on your Google Drive. You may now log out of your Google Drive and continue completing the submission form.
