# CROSS-CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT REQUIREMENT (CCE)

EVERY full-time traditional undergraduate student at Asbury is required to complete CCE.

This Foundations requirement gives students the opportunity to strengthen their abilities to interact with the world community, to expand their worldview, and to increase their cultural sensitivity. Ultimately, we hope that students get to explore how they fit into God's plan of redemption all around the world and develop the competency to effectively serve Christ in a global society.



### Step 1: Take CCE150 (1 credit)

Prior to the cultural immersion experience, students must register for and complete the CCE150 course on campus. We recommend students take this course either in the fall or spring of their first year on campus.

## **Step 2: Submit a Proposal for CCE150EX**

Fill out the online proposal form (asbury.edu/cce), explaining how the proposed experience immerses the student in a culture other than their own. The experience must be at least 6 nights (rubric available online).

# Step 3: Cultural Immersion (CCE150EX)

Participate in the approved experience. Again, the rubric is online. Experiences can be domestic US or international, and can be through the University (study abroad) or separate (church, family travel, etc.). International students may count coming to Asbury as their CCE 150EX.

### **Step 4: Complete 2 Post-Immersion Assignments**

These assignments are described in the CCE150 EX course on students' Discovery AFTER they've taken CCE150.
