Support Letter

Sending a letter or email to at least ten people you know is a great way to get others involved. Better yet, ask these people out for coffee, explain YBL, and then present the letter to them in person! Asking others to support your leadership development is a wonderful way to invite them to invest in you as you walk out what it means to follow Jesus' call in your life. Others can invest in you in several ways. Others can pray for you, they can share about what you are doing, and some others may even feel called to support you financially. If you choose to invite others to support you, the following is a sample letter that you can send to friends and family who are not part of your church family or who may live far away.

It is a wonderful way of involving more people in your growth and passions. It is also a great way to let people know what to pray for in your life! You may also ask your home church to sponsor you in your YBL endeavor. If anyone donates towards your participation, funds should be issued to you not Asbury or YBL.

Get Your Hustle On!

1 Babysitting

Reach out to families you know from your neighborhood or church. Ask if you could babysit for them. Let them know the money you make is going towards your YBL registration fee. Babysitting two nights a week for four weeks will get you half your registration fee or more!

2 Yard Work-

Ask your neighbors if you can rake their yard, wash their car, shovel a driveway, or mow their lawn. Don't forget to remind them that their donation will help you attend YBL.

3 Pet Care

Do you love dogs? See if you can dog walk. Or take care of someone's pet or plants while they are out of town.

3 Bake Sale

Host a bake sale at your school or church. Make a batch of your grandmother's cookies, your aunt's prize-winning pie, or your mom's delicious banana bread. Post about it on social media or ask your church to announce it. Put a base price on the items but remind folks that all the money goes towards your YBL registration fee.


Support Meal

Host a meal and invite friends and family to join you. If your house does not have adequate space, ask your church if there is space you can use or host the meal at a park. You can make a simple meal of soup or spaghetti or ask people to bring something to contribute and make it a potluck meal. After you have prayed over the meal, talk with friends and family about why you have asked them there. Let them know about how their donation will be used.
