

Asbury University Inclement Weather Plan

Plan A:

Given existing weather conditions or the forecasted high probability of a severe weather event that may threaten student and employee safety on campus, **university-on-campus face-to-face instruction will transition to alternate instruction during delayed start times or closure of the University, which may include class cancellation, Zoom-based sessions, or other assignments.** All instructors will advise students on appropriate plans, make-up activities, and/or revised deadlines. Students performing internship or clinical assignments will follow the rules set forth by the Asbury University faculty coordinator. Online instruction is unaffected.

Notes:

- 1. Plan A allows course instruction to be at the faculty member's discretion. It provides faculty with the ability to offer an alternative method of delivery.*
- 2. The faculty members are responsible for communicating alternate instruction to the students. Faculty will communicate with students on how this notification will happen. Email and Discovery announcements are recommended.*
- 3. Faculty are not to penalize students if they cannot attend an online session.*
- 4. Classes will not meet face-to-face for safety reasons.*

Plan B:

Due to severe weather conditions that may threaten student and employee safety on campus and/or significant damage to university infrastructure, in-person and online instruction are unavailable. **All classes are canceled for the day.**
