Finance is a major designed to prepare students for an array of career opportunities. These professions include corporate finance, investor relations, venture capital, commercial and investment banking, financial analysis and planning, and treasury management. The targeted focus of the Finance major is to prepare Asbury students to enter the corporate and investment banking sectors of business. Many students will also enter Asbury's 4+1 MBA program in their senior year of standing.

To graduate must complete all major requirements, foundational requirements, and additional electives needed for 124 hour minimum degree requirement.
