When working at Asbury, central Kentucky offers a wonderful mix of relaxing outdoor adventures, bustling city life in nearby Lexington, and a wide variety of cultural attractions. Located in the "Horse Capital of the World," this Bluegrass area features quiet and peaceful landscapes surrounded by state parks and rivers, perfect for nature enthusiasts.

Asbury is also located less than 20 miles from Lexington, an opportunity-rich hub that is known nationally for its high quality of life and low cost of living. #### **The Opportunity**

The Director of Information Technology Services serves as the Chief Information Officer (CIO) for Asbury University. It is the nature and scope of this position to serve the information technology needs of the academic, student, and administrative sectors of Asbury University. The position provides strategic leadership in developing and implementing both short- and long-term technology plans to respond both to institutional needs and provide a road map to future uses of technology.

As such she/he is responsible for the entire electronic information computing, media, and telecommunications systems including hardware, software, personnel, and operations. Specific managerial functions include coordinating, supervising, and planning for Service Desk, Application Development, academic and administrative software, Instructional Design, Learning Resources technology, data security, and Network Operations. An important part of the position is supporting the ministry and mission of the University and advancing the academic excellence and spiritual vitality of our university and students. Each employee plays a key role in the development of the Christian faith in our students.

The preferred candidate will have a demonstrated history of technology leadership and management, preferably within an educational environment. Possession of strong interpersonal skills and the ability to translate complex technological issues and systems to multiple audiences is a must. In addition, the capacity to think both in the present and the future to lead institutional initiatives focusing on the use of technology to meet the mission of Asbury University.
