Majors in Art and Art Education are offered for students who want to consider a career in any number of visual art and art-related fields, through the study and practice of Art. The Art Grades P–12 Major includes a battery of courses provided by the School of Education, which is approved and accredited by the Kentucky Education Professional Standards Board and accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP). This degree adequately prepares the student for teacher certification in Kentucky.

*Students must complete all Foundations requirements and major requirements, as well as any additional General Electives needed to reach the minimum of 124 total credits required for a Bachelor's degree. This program may require more than 124 credits for a degree due to specific requirements.*
