The Theatre program uses a broad spectrum of areas to prepare the well-rounded, service driven artist. Through experiential learning, students will develop competency in a full range of theatre skills – including performance, design, management, ministry and the technical aspects of production. Recognizing the media’s collaborative nature, each student will also develop greater self-understanding, an appreciation of diversity, and the abilities to listen and to work in a team. As part of the School of Communication Arts, this program complements and is enhanced by the nationally recognized Media Communications Department, allowing the Theatre student to apply their talents to the worlds of Film and Television.

Students must complete all Foundations requirements and major requirements, as well as any additional General Electives needed to reach the minimum of 124 total credits required for a Bachelor’s degree.
